

➔ 2:



I will collect the recycle bins once a week.


Children keep a record of their hours spent on their challenge. Children need to complete a minimum of 5 hours to gain a Hi5 Award but can do more!




## Show what you did in your Challenge


Write, draw, add a photo, or show in any way you choose.



I helped put the bins out around the playground.




Children can draw, write and even add photos or stickers to make a story about what they did to complete their challenge. Additional pages can be added if they would like to show more of what they did.
