CareerSense Find Your Path is an employability programme for young people aged 16-24 based in Edinburgh, with 6 weeks of skills training sessions to ensure you feel ready for work, followed by a 4 week **paid** work placement at Royal Bank of Scotland/ NatWest in Gogarburn.

Skills Sessions

Sessions will support young people to explore their key skills, develop a positive work mindset, and learn about career pathways, the workplace and applying for jobs.

Mentoring

8 sessions of one to one Mentor support to help young people create a personal work profile, build a professional relationship, and set goals for the future.

Work Experience

Work Insight days and a work placement to exercise new skills and build confidence. **Paid** the National Living Wage.

Who can take part?

Young people aged 16-24 who are not in education or employment and:

- Work-ready but lack experience, confidence and networks.
- Interested in opportunities and further developing themselves.
- Facing additional barriers, e.g. those who are care experienced, have mental health or learning difficulties or low levels of qualification.
- A UK resident or have the right to work in the UK.
- Able to attend programme sessions in person.
